RECREATION


Marin's proximity to San Francisco makes it a natural choice for outdoor fun. Pedal across the Golden Gate Bridge to bike trails that trace the coast. For splendid landscapes, hike Rodeo Beach or Mount Tamalpais (*Mt. Tam to the locals*). Explore by air with Seaplane Adventures (seaplane.com) or, for an on-the-water experience, rent kayaks or stand up paddleboards from Sea Trek (seatrek.com).

DINING Sausalito's restaurant scene features recent waterfront additions like Barrel House Tavern (barrelhousetavern. com) and the Trident. Once a favorite of famous rockers, it's been restored to its 1960s-era splendor (thetridentsausalito. com). Musician Sammy Hagar and celebrity chef Tyler Florence operate El Paseo over in Mill Valley, serving guests in a stylishly renovated 1940s steakhouse. Craving fresh seafood? Ferry to Sam's Anchor Cafe in Tiburon (samscafe.com), or snag a patio seat at Sausalito standbys Fish (331fish. com) or Salito's (salitoscrabhouse.com).

SHOPPING Sausalito's shopping district promises everything from keepsakes to clothing to art. Look to Heath Ceramics for a slice of California style (heathceramics.com). In Mill Valley, buzzworthy boutiques such as The Store (thestoremillvalley. com) and Summer House (summer house57millvalley. com) carry designer clothing and creative home accessories. Try Tiburon's retailers for books, jewelry and the latest by area artists.

GETTING THERE

From San Francisco, head north on Highway 101, board a ferry (most depart from the Ferry Building or Pier 41) or bike up and ferry back.
